**South Port Day Links (SPDL)** is a not for profit organisation that has been providing volunteer services to residents of the City of Port Phillip for over 25 years. We aim to help residents maintain their social connections and support their ability to live independently.

## What We Do

**DayLinks** – A door to door program that provides flexible community transport. This allows residents to access health appointments, recreational, shopping and other activities essential to everyday living.

**PetLinks** – Assists eligible residents care for their animal companions at home with grooming, walking dogs and visits to the vet with the support of a volunteer.

**WalkMates** – Links a suitable volunteer to an eligible resident who needs encouragement &/or physical assistance to go for a walk.

**GardenMates** – Links volunteers who enjoy gardening with people who cannot maintain their gardens due to reduced physical mobility.

**InfoLink** – Provides information about services in the local community and is the contact point for booking the DayLinks service.

**Betty's Bus Trips** – Monthly recreational outings for residents to enjoy lunch at various scenic locations around Melbourne
